The idyllic town, through which the River Salze meanders, boasts a pretty town center. Salzsiederstadt harmonically combines history and modernity. Many of the richly decorated half-timbered houses in the old town were built in the 16th and 17th centuries and still bear witness to the economic prosperity of Bad Salzuflen in those days. It was during this period that the European Renaissance architectural style took on a special character in the Weser region. This also applies to the historic center of Bad Salzuflen.
